#### SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The NILS India Business Law Review ascribes to the following submission guidelines for Authors -

1. All manuscripts submitted which are to be considered for publication in *NILS India Business Law Review* “NIBLR” must be original and should not have been published elsewhere.
2. *Articles* must deal with issues of interest and relevance and must demonstrate a high-level of analysis. Articles of a purely descriptive nature, unless about a development in a country or a region which may necessarily be of a descriptive nature, are not preferred.
3. Manuscripts with a word length of 8,000-15,000 words are published as *Articles*.
4. *Notes* that capture recent policy and development in law in accordance with the thematic component of the issue are welcome by the Review.
5. *Comments* must entail a critical analysis of a case laws and policy developments in accordance with the thematic component of the issue. Manuscripts with a word length below 8,000 words are published as *Notes* and *Comments*.
6. NIBLR welcomes any suggestions from academicians, scholars or publishers for *Book Reviews*.
7. An “Abstract” of 500 words must precede the body of the manuscript (except in case of Book Reviews).
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9. As a matter of standard convention, British English must be followed.
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1. Authors may submit manuscripts in accordance with the above laid down guidelines by way of e-mail.
2. A maximum of three Authors are permitted per article. Authors are encouraged to employ gender neutral language.
3. The main text of the manuscript must follow a font size of 12 Times New Roman with 1.5 line spacing and a font size of 10 Times New Roman with 1.0 lines spacing for footnotes.
4. We do not accept submissions on a rolling basis as each issue is theme based.
5. The Journal only accepts electronic submission file in Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx) format with minimum use of Macros.
6. Authors are required to send an updated CV (s) mentioning the Name(s) of the Author(s), Institution/Affiliation, qualifications and contact details, the Title of the manuscript as well as a cover letter is to be submitted along with the Manuscript.
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
